Just lost one of our lecturers, a psychologist who used to teach some topics in Early childhood in the department. It is sad for us indeed. But I guess that is life. Owen and I are planning to go to the site sometime next week after our curriculum review workshop and that will be on Thursday. We will then be able to give you a full picture of what is happening.
