
Your proposal was evaluated on the basis of the selection and award criteria announced in the text of the above call for proposals. The following comments summarize the reasons for the rejection of your application:

The project presents an interesting approach to "deinstitutionalisation" based on the participation of a large spectrum of NGOs. However it lacks clear innovative features. The deliverables could provide added value, but the mainstreaming potential is not fully convincing.
