Subject: The case of Ms Roelie Post

Ms. Roelie Post, an European *fonctionnaire* reinstated into DG Enlargement since August 2014, feels that she has been harassed within the European Commission for helping expose what happened with institutionalized children in Romania and change the Romanian authorities attitudes and international connivance with child trafficking.

I know that she wrote to the Secretary-General of the European Commission, Ms Catherine Day, about her case.

From what I know of her role in Romania, I believe that Ms. Post should be considered a whistle-blower and should thus be protected, instead of punished.

I would be grateful if, in your position as Vice-President of the Commission, you would re-evaluate her case and take the necessary steps to protect Ms. Roelie Post and ensure that she is not negatively discriminated or further harassed.
