ICA in the past has been almost non-existent as they Namibian authorities put a lot of importance to implement properly the principle of subsidiarity. Therefore, I am not really sure about the needs for ICA. I would advise being extremely careful.

# WORKSHOP ON THE 1993 HAGUE CONVENTION FOR AFRICAN (ANGLOPHONE) STATES



#### **Draft Concept Note**

The Permanent Bureau proposes the organisation of a 3 day and a half workshop on the implementation and operation of the 1993 Hague Convention on the Protection of Children and Cooperation in Respect of Intercountry Adoption ("the 1993 Hague Convention" or the "Convention") for Anglophone African States.

The workshop, which is scheduled to take place tentatively in South Africa (tbc) in 2017 will be attended by the Central Authorities and competent authorities of Anglophone African States party to the 1993 Hague Convention and Anglophone African States interested in becoming a party, and a few receiving States supporting financially this initiative and who co-operate with the States of origin invited. At present there are 18 African States that have signed and ratified or acceded to the Hague Convention of 1993.<sup>1</sup>

# I. OBJECTIVES, PRINCIPLES AND METHODOLOGIES FOR THE WORKSHOP

#### Objectives

- To strengthen knowledge on the 1993 Hague Convention and promote a better its understanding;
- To study the practical implementation of the Convention in the States of origin and cooperation between States regarding good practices;
- . To encourage other States to sign and ratify or accede to the Convention;
- To implement the recommendations of the Declaration on the need to develop a harmonised framework for the adoption of children in Africa adopted by African States during the last 2015 Special Commission to review the operation of the Convention, and the Conclusions and Recommendations of 2009 and 2012 African Workshops.<sup>2</sup>

#### Focus

Experiences, issues and challenges typically encountered by States of origin concerned, in respect of adoption and the issues of implementation of the Convention.

#### Methodology

# REPORT OF THE WORKING GROUP ON PREVENTING AND ADDRESSING ILLICIT PRACTICES IN INTERCOUNTRY ADOPTION (Meeting of 8 – 10 July 2020)

#### I. Introduction

- 1. From 8 to 10 July 2020, the Working Group on Preventing and Addressing Illicit Practices in Intercountry Adoption (hereinafter "the Group") met via videoconference. The meeting was attended by 58 participants representing 24 States, including both States of origin and receiving States, and four international organisations, as well as members of the Permanent Bureau (hereinafter "PB").
- 2. The mandate of the Group is "to consider the development of more effective and practical forms of cooperation between States to prevent and address specific instances of abuse", 1 and more specifically, to "develop a Toolkit containing the elements described in the [2016] Report" of the Working Group.2
- 3. At its 2020 meeting, the HCCH's Council on General Affairs and Policy ("CGAP") endorsed the proposal of the Group to hold another meeting.<sup>3</sup> The 2020 meeting of the Group focused on revision of the draft Toolkit.
- 4. One of the main objectives of the meeting was to have the Group agree on the structure of this Toolkit, with the objective of presenting an advanced draft for the consideration of the next meeting of the Special Commission on the practical operation of the Convention of 29 May 1993 on Protection of Children and Co-operation in Respect of Intercountry Adoption (hereinafter, "1993 Adoption Convention"), tentatively scheduled for June 2021.
- 5. The Group reaffirmed that the proposed Toolkit would be a valuable resource to assist States in identifying, preventing and addressing illicit practices. The Group agreed that the voices of adoptees should be taken into account in drafting this Toolkit.

#### II. Draft Toolkit

- 6. The Group discussed the structure of the Toolkit and agreed that it should include Fact Sheets, a Model Procedure and Guidelines, as described in the sections below. In addition, the Group agreed to include a Checklist for individual cases based on a proposal made by Canada ahead of the meeting.
- 7. The Group agreed that each tool of the Toolkit may be read separately and may serve different purposes.
- 8. The Group reminded its previous recommendation that "the Toolkit should address how to respond to all cases of illicit practices, including those in non-Convention countries and those preceding the entry into force of the 1993 [Adoption] Convention." However, some participants raised possible concerns as to applying the Toolkit to cases preceding the entry into force of the 1993 Adoption Convention.

#### A. Fact Sheets

- 9. The Fact Sheets would be directed at Central Authorities, other competent authorities and bodies. They may also be useful when providing technical assistance, for States becoming Party to the Convention or State Parties wishing to improve their system.
- 10. The participants discussed the structure of the Fact Sheets and reaffirmed that they should include the following:
  - a section identifying the relevant illicit practices;
  - a section identifying systemic weaknesses and enabling factors that may facilitate or promote the occurrence of such illicit practices;
  - a section on prevention of such illicit practices; and
  - a section with additional information and further resources.
- 11. The Group discussed several alternative structures and finally agreed that the structure should be composed of two columns, with the illicit practices or enabling factors and preventive measures side by side.
- 12. The Group discussed the content of some of the Fact Sheets, as well as removing or adding new topics for Fact Sheets, and agreed that the Fact Sheets should cover the following topics:
  - 1) abduction, sale of and traffic in children;
  - misrepresentation of identity;
  - 3) forgery and falsification of documents;
  - 4) adoptability: lack of, or deficient, consent;
  - 5) misrepresentation of adoptability of children of unknown parents;
  - failure to respect subsidiarity;
  - improper matching;
  - 8) no preservation of, and access to, records;
  - 9) circumventing the adoption procedure;
  - 10) improper financial or other gain.

- 13. The Group also discussed whether to include a Fact Sheet regarding the improper assessment of the eligibility and suitability of the prospective adoptive parents or to include this topic further in other Fact Sheets. The Group acknowledged the importance of this topic, its connection to the breakdown of adoptions and the need for further work in this area, in a manner that is not strictly related to illicit practices, recognising that it has practical consequences in the final result of an intercountry adoption process.<sup>5</sup>
- 14. In relation to the Fact Sheet on improper financial gain, the Group discussed how to frame the points regarding medical and maintenance costs, keeping in mind consistency with the Note on Financial Aspects and Conclusion and Recommendation No 9 agreed upon by the Group at its 2019 meeting.
- 15. In relation to the Fact Sheets on abduction, sale and traffic in children and on consent, participants agreed to develop further the issue of inducement.

# B. Checklist to Assist Decision Making by Central Authorities in Light of Existing Risks of Illicit Activity

- 16. The Group considered the new proposal to include a Checklist in the Toolkit. The Checklist would assist Central Authorities, and if applicable adoption accredited bodies, in taking decisions in individual cases of adoption and in identifying what they should watch out for and what actions they should take to prevent illicit activity from permeating or influencing the adoption process, following the steps of the adoption procedure.
- 17. Many participants welcomed this proposal for its practicality. They indicated that such a Checklist would complement the Fact Sheets and agreed that this Checklist should be used as an additional tool, rather than as a replacement for the Fact Sheets.

### C. Model Procedure to Respond to Suspected and Actual Cases of Illicit Practices

- 18. There was general support that the Model Procedure should include the following steps:<sup>6</sup>
  - disclosure and recording of suspected cases of illicit practices;
  - considerations of temporary child protection measures;
  - services to impacted persons;
  - investigation;
  - informing concerned authorities, bodies and persons; and
  - possible actions following the investigation.
- 19. The Group agreed that the Model Procedure should cover both responses to individual cases of illicit practices and responses in cases of a pattern of illicit practices.
- 20. The Group agreed that the Model Procedure is aimed at all State actors connected to the case.
- 21. The Group discussed to whom this Model Procedure should be addressed. Some participants pointed out the possible challenges relating to certain of the services<sup>7</sup> and the political nature of some of the measures described in the Model Procedure. Nonetheless, many participants emphasised the importance that the Model Procedure be addressed to all State actors and recognised the value of proposing a wide array of measures. In any case, the Group agreed to make it clear that not all services

and measures may be available in all States and that each State may develop its own procedure based on its own legislative and institutional framework, as well as their available resources.

22. The Group acknowledged the importance of the best interests of the child in addressing suspected and actual cases of illicit practices and the need to be sensitive to concerns of adoptees, as well as birth and adoptive families. Similarly, the Group expressed the need to take into account not only the short, but also the long-term effects on the adoptee of any action taken to address the illicit practice.

# D. Guidelines on Preventing and Responding to Patterns of Illicit Practices

- 23. The Group agreed that the Guidelines should be a separate tool focusing on cooperation and coordination to prevent and respond to illicit practices, including patterns.
- 24. Some participants stated that they would like to see more references as to how technology and data analysis may be used to identify patterns of illicit practices.

# III. Next Steps

- 25. The Group agreed with the following next steps regarding the Toolkit:
  - Participants are requested to provide any further comments in writing on each tool (i.e., Fact Sheets, Checklist, Model Procedure, Guidelines) to the PB by 30 September 2020.
  - The PB will revise the Fact Sheets, the Model Procedure and the Guidelines, while Canada will
    revise the Checklist, in light of the comments received during the meeting and through written
    submissions after the meeting.
  - Once revised, the full Toolkit will be sent to all HCCH Members, Contracting Parties to the 1993
    Adoption Convention, and relevant international organisations in preparation for the next
    Special Commission meeting tentatively scheduled for June 2021.
  - The final version of the Toolkit will be submitted to CGAP for approval.
- 26. The Chair of the Working Group will report on the status of the Group's work to CGAP at its 2021 meeting.



Dear All,

With this email I would like to inform you about recent developments in the Netherlands regarding intercountry adoption and the work of the independent committee.

In the past years we received several worrying signals about intercountry adoption procedures that took place in the past ('70 – '90's). Therefore the Minister for Legal Protection established an independent committee ("the Committee Investigating Intercountry adoption in the past"). Over the last one and a half year this Committee conducted a thorough investigation about possible illicit practices in the past (1967-1998).

Today, February 8, this Committee presented its report to our Minister. The Committee concluded that in the past illicit practices occurred and the adoption infrastructure was not sufficient to serve the best interest of the children. Despite its' awareness of wrongdoings, the Dutch authorities were negligent in taking necessary measures to prevent illicit practices from happening. The Committee also concluded that until today wrongdoings and illicit practices can take place and the intercountry adoption infrastructure is unable to prevent this from happening. It is therefore that the Committee recommends to consider an alternative, public infrastructure on intercountry adoption. Meanwhile it recommends suspension of all intercountry adoption procedures in the Netherlands. In response to the report, the Minister for legal protection acknowledged the negligence of the Dutch authorities in the past and expressed his regrets towards the adoptees. He also decided to suspend all new applications for intercountry adoption. In the meantime the possibilities for an alternative, public infrastructure on intercountry adoption will be explored. As elections are due, it is for a new Government to take further decisions with regards to intercountry adoption. The Minister decided that all prospective adoptive parents whom are in possession of a so called 'permit in principle' (in which is stated that they are eligible and suitable to adopt in general) have the possibility to proceed with their adoption procedure. The procedure for all new applicants, or for people whom are in the process of receiving a permit in principle, will go on hold.

Thanks for your email.

Regarding your question. According to the 1993 Adoption Convention "A competent authority which finds that any provision of the Convention has not been respected or that there is a serious risk that it may not be respected, shall immediately inform the Central Authority of its State. This Central Authority shall be responsible for ensuring that appropriate measures are taken" (Art. 33). However, under the Convention there is no obligation to report illicit practice to the PB of the HCCH. Nevertheless, it is a good practice to inform the PB about illicit practices and other issues linked to the implementation of the Convention. This allows the PB to be aware of the challenges on practical operation of the Convention, and include those issues, as appropriate, for discussions in meetings of a relevant Working Group and / or a Special Commission on the practical operation of the Convention. While the PB is not a Court or a Tribunal, it can, within its limited resources, assist States in cooperating together, and if needed, contact relevant States to better identify issue and assist them in discussing how they could prevent and address them.
