I hope that this e-mail receives you well.

First of all, I would like to express my warmest wishes for 2025.

I'm contacting you as a staff member of the Flemish Central Authority on intercountry adoption in Belgium. In 2018 we had the pleasure visiting the MOC Kolkata as well as the motherhouse. We had a lovely meeting with  who took the time for guiding is us around and giving us more information of the work of the MOC.

Next week we'll be travelling again to India and we will be as from the 24th of January in Kolkata. I will travel with our Director,  en colleague  and

gain we would love to bring a visit to the MOC Kolkata and motherhouse. As we have many adoptees from the past contacting us for more information on their roots and identity it could be very beneficial for us as for them to be able to provide them correct information. It helps us also to understand how adoptions in the past took place in order to create more context.

As our days are limited we would love to visit on **Saturday the 25th of January**. Could you indicate what time suits you best?

A second focus of our visit pertains to concerns raised regarding potential irregularities in certain adoption cases. Our former Minister of Welfare, Health, and Family, Mrs. Crevits, initiated a process allowing individuals to report any suspicions of abuse or malpractice in their adoption files to our central authority. To date, we have received over 200 such reports. Among these, there are several related to India. Consequently, we are exploring opportunities to collaborate with potential partners who could assist in investigating these cases. We would like to explain you a little bit more on this as well during our visit.

We look forward to your reply and the possibility to meet in person.
