I hope this email finds you well. I am writing to you in regard to the pleasant and productive meeting we, the Flemish Central Authority of Belgium, had with [REDACTED] and the rest of the team back in January. Following our discussion, I reached out a few times to schedule a follow-up meeting, but unfortunately, I haven't received a response. I have since learned that [REDACTED] is no longer available, so I would like to revisit my request.

We have decided to cease collaboration with India on future intercountry adoptions, and we would like to explain our reasons in detail during our next meeting. Additionally, we are keen to discuss arrangements for the significant number of adoptees who have questions about their roots. We would like to refer to [REDACTED] suggestion of organizing a digital information session (where we could submit questions in advance). This would allow you, as the Central Authority, to provide context regarding historical adoptions and the differences between past and present practices, as well as what you may or may not mean for the adoptees.

I have attached a letter that encapsulates the main conclusions and recommendations following our work visit, as previously shared. **Could we please schedule a virtual meeting at your earliest convenience to discuss these matters further?**
